



Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP)

The ACP is a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) program to help low-income households pay for internet service and connected devices.

Eligibility

Eligible households may receive:

- Up to \$30/month discount on internet service.
- Up to \$75/month discount if the household is on qualifying Tribal lands.
- A one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, table, or desktop computer (with a co-payment of more than \$10 but less than \$50)

A household is eligible if **one** member of the household meets at least **one** of the criteria below:

- Has an income that is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines;
- Participates in certain assistance programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or Lifeline;
- Participates in one of several Tribal specific programs, such as Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance, Tribal Head Start (only households meeting the relevant income qualifying standard) Tribal TANF, or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations;
- Is approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year; or
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating broadband provider's existing low-income program.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Only one monthly service discount and one device discount is allowed per household. Not all participating internet service providers offer device discounts.

How do I enroll?

Eligible households can enroll two ways:

- 1) Through a **participating broadband provider**
- 2) Go to **AffordableConnectivity.gov** and submit an online application. You may also choose to print a mail-in application. The next step is to contact your preferred participating broadband provider and selecting a plan.
